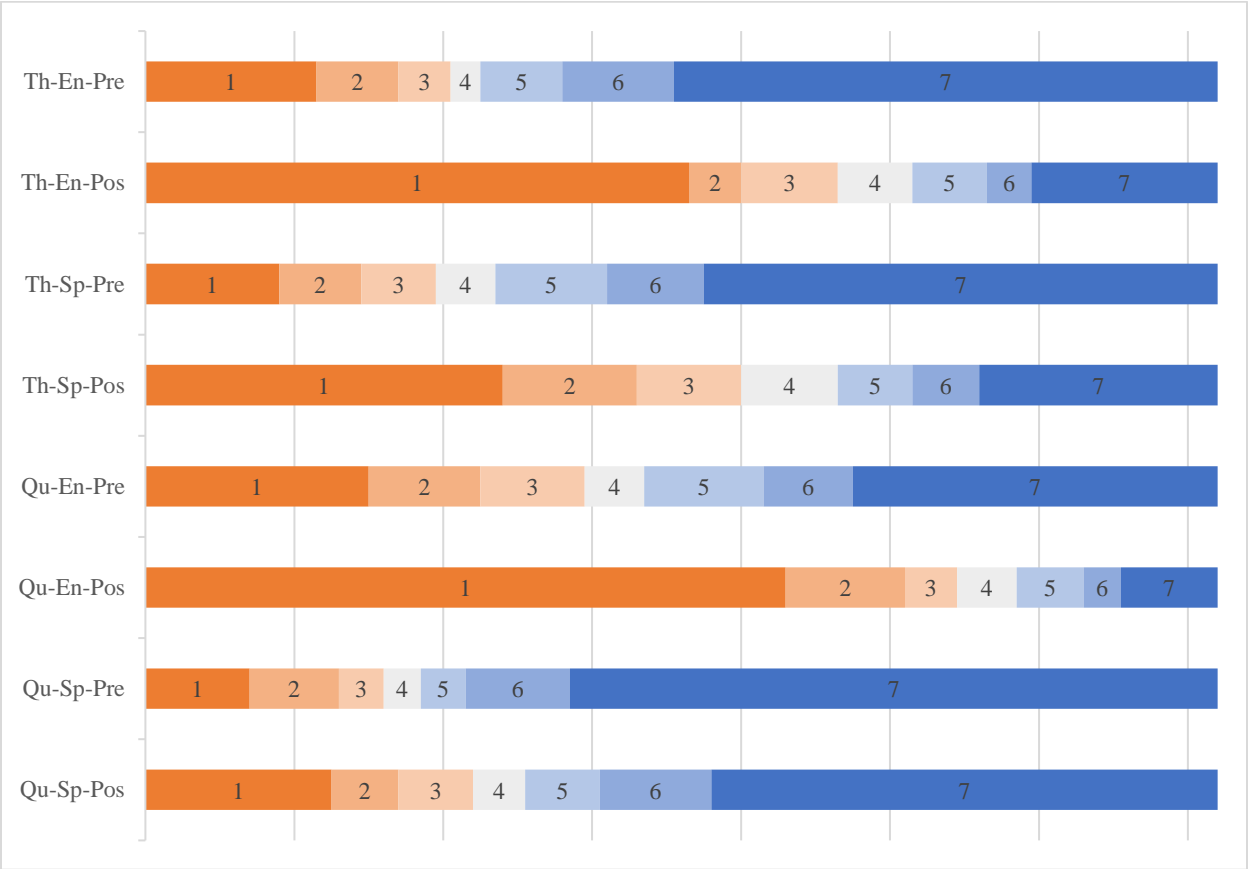


Figure A.1: Distribution of ratings by condition.
